





<u>Lesson One</u>: For this lesson, we will be reading the book *Ten Red Apples* by Pat Hutchins. We will use props to tell the story and practice counting from one to ten. We will also learn a new song about apples.

At Home Activity: make your own book about apples to read.

<u>Lesson Two</u>: We will enjoy one of my favorites, *Ten Apples Up On Top* by Dr. Seuss. We will use the characters in the story to make a graph. We will sing our apple song and learn an apple rhyme.

At Home Activity: Ten Apples Up On Top cut and paste.

Lesson Three: Today we will watch a short video that shows the life cycle of an apple in more detail while talking more about how an apple changes many times before it is ready to eat. Book: **How Do Apples Grow** by Jill McDonald. We will then make a graph about apples. We will sing our apple song and say our apple rhyme.

At Home Activity: Letter A Hunt.

<u>Lesson Four</u>: Today's book will be *An Apple's Life* by Nancy Dickmann where we will learn more about the life cycle of an apple. We will also discuss how we can use our 5 senses when eating apples. We will sing our apple song and say our apple rhyme.

At Home Activity: Apple life cycle cut and paste.

Lesson Five: Today's read aloud is **The Apple Pie Tree** by Zoe Hall. We will discuss all we've learned about apples this week. We will talk about what a recipe is and will practice following a recipe to make pretend apple pies. We will also have a fun science experiment with apple seeds.

At Home Activity: The Apple Pie Tree patterns cut and paste.

Skills: counting, number recognition, letter and sound recognition, story retelling, rhyming, science, graphing, sequencing, parts of a book, print has meaning.
